1. May God be with you
In this coming year,
Any may it be the sweetest

2. Each day, remind Him you are His; that you desire to spend this day as pleases Him.
3. Whenever you can, take a few minutes of just waiting on Jesus, not necessarily praying, but just waiting, looking into His face, desiring His presence.
4. Aim to praise at all times – even if you don't feel like praising right now-
5. Do you give yourself time for prayer and Just Jesus?
6. No matter what the other one does, you live –practice-- the love life.
7. Make me to be hungry and thirsty for Thyself –just Jesus- to desire you more.
8. The truths of the Bible are but pathways to the feet of Jesus.
9. All Holy Ghost filled people who have received Him have a right to be more and more abundantly baptized –frequently refilled-
10. Don't look on the dark side of faith things, but on the faith side of dark things.
11. It is dangerous to give yourself, and then draw back.
